

Buckhead North HOA Pool Rules

Effective April 2017; subject to change

1. Only Buckhead North Residents and their guests are allowed to use pools. 4 guest maximum per household applies. Residents must be current on all fees due the association in order to be eligible to use community amenities.
2. Residents will be held liable for damage caused by themselves, their children or their guests.
3. Unattended, solo use of pools is prohibited.
4. Children under 13 years of age shall not use pools without a supervising adult in attendance.
5. Children under 3 years of age or not potty trained must wear leak-proof swimwear.
6. Appropriate swimwear must be worn when using pools.
7. No food, drink, wrappers, or glass containers shall be permitted within 8 feet of pools.
8. No running, rough play, no abusive, profane or foul language, no loud noises, and no bullying allowed in pools area.
9. No spitting, spouting or nose blowing while in pools.
10. No jumping or standing on pool furniture.
11. No use of pools when raining or if thunder or lightning can be heard or seen.
12. Persons with contagious, communicable or infective illnesses or diseases not allowed in pools or pool area.
13. Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, cough or infected eyes or ears not allowed in pool area.
14. The following items are not allowed in pools or pool area: alcoholic beverages, all forms of tobacco, animals, bikes, chewing gum, glass articles, hair clips, hair pins, motorized equipment, radio controlled or battery operated toys, roller blades, sharp objects, skateboards, snorkeling or scuba equipment.
15. When directed to do so by HOA personnel, individuals must immediately leave pool area.
16. All trash and litter must be placed in available receptacles.
17. Persons violating rules may be asked to surrender their pool key cards.
